Dear Parent/Guardian:

The State of Massachusetts requires the following information for entrance of your child to **Kindergarten**.

- Report of a physical exam within the past year
- Complete list of Immunizations- (including the following mandatory doses: DTaP 5 doses, Polio 4 doses, Hep B 3 doses, MMR 2 doses and Varicella 2 doses)
- Report of a Lead test
- Vision Screening -is usually found on physical exam if missing must call MD for documentation (see bold below)

Massachusetts State Law mandates that “Upon entering kindergarten or within 30 days of the start of the school year, the parent or guardian of each child shall present to school health personnel certification that the child within the past 12 months has passed a vision screening...”

This notice is being sent now to alert you to state requirements since it may take several months to get an appointment with your pediatrician. *Please disregard this general reminder if you have already sent in an updated physical/immunizations from this year.

This information is currently due!

NO STUDENT WILL BE ALLOWED TO ATTEND SCHOOL WITHOUT ALL OF THE ABOVE REQUIREMENTS.
